






#### What is Positive Peace

Peace that is underpinned by having the attitudes, institutions and structures that create and sustain peaceful societies is referred to as Positive Peace. High levels of Positive Peace occur when attitudes make violence less



tolerated, institutions are more responsive to society's needs, and structures underpin the nonviolent resolution of grievances. Positive Peace is also underpinned by justice, equality and harmonious social relations.

### What is Rotary's role in Promoting Positive Peace

Rotary envisioned the importance of Promoting Positive Peace with the involvement of Rotarians throughout the world. In this connection, Rotary entered into a Strategic Partnership with the Institute of Economics and Peace (IEP) in 2017, to promote Positive Peace.
